The tour invites you to discover Prenzlauer Berg on your own. Using selected photographs and Hauswald's memories, the atmosphere of Prenzlauer Berg

in the late GDR comes to life. The pictures, stories, and videos show not only historical events but above all the everyday lives of the people, their hopes, and their resistance. The traces of the past lead to well-known and hidden places. Whether on foot, by bike, or by public transport – the pace and choice of route are entirely up to the explorer.
